BACKGROUND

The Raid Cani-Trail is a long distance multi day event organised by Cani-Trail UK on the above dates.

It starts (10th) and finishes (12th) at Llanharan Welfare Hall (CF72 9NR) – there is a separate RA for the Welfare Hall (001/RAID/2026)

The event follows set routes and is marked with GPX files available to each participants. The routes cross a variety of different terrain and is advertised as an “off road” event. The routes whilst on public footpaths and bridleways may cross land that is farmed by private owners

As part of entry all participants are directed to the company Terms & Conditions on the website (www.canitrailuk.co.uk) and a safety brief is completed by the RD (J Fletcher) prior to departure on the first day with any updates daily if required.

Entry to this event is at the participants own risk, however we have identified any risk to minimise anything potential.
