



## 1. EVENT LOCATION / RACE HQ / CAMPING AREA

The nearest postcode is the Chapel **CF35 6NP**

Keep going uphill until you go onto the top common where you will see the camping area to your right and a Welsh Flag on a sign post – this is the entrance.

This is about 500 metres uphill past the chapel at the following Google maps link:

If you follow the Google Maps link it will bring you straight to it. On planning your journey I WOULD ADVISE NOT APPROACHING THE SITE FROM GLYNOGWR OR GILFACH AREA

**PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLIER THAN 1230hrs FRIDAY 14th**

The site is an open area on a hill. There is no electric hook up

There are Portaloos on site.

PLEASE DO NOT EMPTY YOUR PORTABLE TOILETS OR CARTRIDGES IN THESE AS ONCE FULL THERE IS NOTHING WE CAN DO and cannot empty them over the weekend.

Please bring your own water for cooking etc

Water on site in containers is for the event only.

The site is suitable for small campers, cars and small caravans. However if it is heavy rain it may be challenging for caravans – **PLEASE BEAR THIS IN MIND BEFORE TRAVELLING**

We have had 3 dry run throughs in all weathers and had success if vehicles are stranded with 4x4 and tractors.

**Rubbish / Dog Feaces etc** Please take this with you and tidy up at all times during the event

**WE DO NOT HAVE THE FACILITIES TO TAKE IN THE VOLUME OF RUBBISH!!!**

**Open Fires** are Prohibited at all times but obviously cookers are suitable but must not be left unattended.

**Dogs** are to be kept on the line / lead at all times before, during and after running /racing. You are responsible for your dog at all times throughout the duration of this event.

There may be livestock on the area such as sheep if you encounter these **STOP**, Let them pass – PLEASE DO NOT RUN THROUGH THEM OR CHASE THEM DOWN!!

If you encounter horse riders STOP and wait the riders instructions.

### 3. REGISTRATION FOR EVENT

Registration for the event will be at the tent near the site entrance and from 1330hrs Friday 14<sup>th</sup>

You will need to complete a disclaimer and there will be a copy on the private group. If you can please print off and bring it completed with you to save time.

You collect your bib number – Please keep this for all the stages / routes.

### 4. KIT LIST

There is a minimal kit list for this event. It is your responsibility to dress appropriately for the routes on the day and weather

- Fully Charged Mobile Phone (On Loud & Vibrate)
- Trail Trainers / Hiking Boots
- HQ Contact Number
- Minimal 2 x 500ml water (10km & 17km routes) so you will require something suitable such as an ultra or running pack for these to be carried.

### Weather Dependant

– Water proof Jacket (Trousers if Required and you are trekking it)

Advisable Warm Top



## 5. DOG EQUIPMENT

Dogs are to be run / trekked in a “Non Restrictive” Harness that does not inhibit the natural movement of the shoulders. If you are unsure please ask via e mail.

The event organisers decision is final on harness suitability.

You are to run in a waist belt and suitable bungee line.

Dogs on leads attached to collars are not permitted to run.

## 6. TRAIL ETIQUETTE

It is your responsibility to control your dog at all times during the event. We are not responsible for any injuries regarding dog fights.

If you have a reactive dog then please ask to either go first or move out of the way until you feel it is ok for you to start.

When passing another entrant let them know “Coming Through or your right / left etc” also give extra room and if required reign your dog in slightly.

## 7. ROUTES / EVENTS

**Friday** 1700hrs 8km Route – **May put back to 1800hrs weather dependant.**

**Saturday** AM (0800hrs TBC) – 17km Route

**Saturday** PM (2200hrs TBC) – 3.4km Night Route (Optional)

**Sunday** AM (0800hrs TBC) – 10km

For all routes there will be a window of 15 minutes.

**EG:** Clock starts at 0800hrs and you have 15 mins to start. The idea being if you are chasing a win/place then you start on the dot. If you want to trek or have a reactive dog arrive within the 15 minutes.

The Night Route there will be a 5 second intervals and it is not timed.

If you are a faster runners set off at the start. If you have a reactive dog then start early or at the rear (you know your dog)

There are medals for all finishers and 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> Placed for both the 17km & 10km as will be shown on the private group.

There will be a Cani-Trail Dog Tag / Medal for your K9 Pal

All routes are marked by white arrow and there will be marshals at various points to guide you.

There is water at various checkpoints areas on routes and I have ensured there is running water on the routes for dogs.
