HQ LOCATION

Page | 1 The event HQ along with START & FINISH will take place at Llanharan Welfare Hall

(Post Code CF72 9RA)

CAMPING / PARKING

Camping will be from Friday 1730hrs – 1200hrs Sunday –

Note the site is not suitable for Caravans. Cars, Camper vans and small motorhomes only.

If you require to park up and camp for the weekend then there is a **£20 fee payable direct via BACs** details provided nearer the time.

Camping / Parking for weekend includes showers / toilets (There is no electric hook up).

Parking for the event on the day – there is ample space, however if full there is parking at Llanharan Train Station which is free – Please do not park near the Veterinary Surgery or Flats outside of the Hall Entrance. The site will close for the start of the 50 mile 0700hrs so please be patient and try to not arrive around this time.

Dogs are to be kept on the line / lead at all times at the venue. Please walk your dogs around the Sports Pitches and not on them at anytime.

Feaces is to be cleaned up and placed in the bins.

Dogs are allowed in the Main Hall but you are responsible for your dogs actions at all times.

Registration For Both routes:

Friday 19th March 1900-2230 (Ideally all 50 Entrants)

Saturday 20th March 50 Mile (priority) 0530-0630 **30 Mile** 0800-0900

At registration you will:

- Complete disclaimer
- Kit Check (Bring all your kit including Dog equipment to registration)
- Collect Bib Number
- Collect GPS Tracker fitted to your running pack

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GPS Tracker will be fitted on the shoulder of your pack – **IT IS NOT TO BE REMOVED OR TAMPERED WITH!!!** If your tracker is lost unfortunately you will be charged for this.

- Mobile Phone Fully Charged (Switched on and loud mode)
- Head Torch
- **50 Route Only** – Power source (to re charge mobile Phone)
- Extra Batteries or similar charging (in addition to what is inside torch)
- Waterproof Jacket – Taped Seams
- Waterproof Trousers – Taped Seams
- Warm Top (Not to be worn at start – It is to put on in an Emergency)
- Hat & Gloves
- Emergency Bivi – Foil Blanket Not Acceptable
- Snacks or similar

Mandatory Dog Equipment

- Canicross or Trekking Harness -
See Terms & Conditions page on website for information suitability. If unsure contact us direct.
- Canicross Bungee or trekking Line
- Canicross or Trekking Waistbelt

Advisable

- Ultra / Walking / Trekking Poles
- Sun Cream (if sunny)
- Small K9 First aid kit
- Collapsible dog Bowl

Safety Brief – Mandatory for all participants!!!

50 Mile – 0645hrs - Route Start 0700hrs

30 Mile 0845hrs- Route Start 0900hrs

It is your responsibility to attend the safety brief.

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Whilst you are at the safety brief marshals will be going round activating trackers. If you have not had it done then please do so or you wont be tracked for safety or your time and be placed. Trackers are set to be live at 0700hrs for 50 and 0900hrs for the 30.

Start – For Both Routes

Will be en masse at the front of the hall and behind the arch. Please common sense prevails so fan out and obviously if you have a reactive dog then either hold back or go to the front.

There will be a bottle neck going out of the site entrance. Keep to Left and go over foot bridge (not road) and across the square where we will have marshals to direct you. Once you go uphill you the group(s) will spread out and onto the trails.

50 Mile Route

Entry to the 50 is on the understanding you can navigate safely in hills or mountains and in the dark.

Entry to the 50 is on the understanding that you are confident of doing this long distance and meeting the cut off to complete it.

The route is Marked in places by white marker arrow and signage.

There is a GPX File available – Note this may change due to weather conditions and or any safety issues.

The route can be followed by the GPX tracker you are wearing via an app

The route will also be available on OS Maps app – we recommend the Topo Maps subscription £6.99 for 1 month)

There is a cut of for this route- you will need to of reached the Car Park Checkpoint at Evanstown by 2359hrs (40 miles) which is 17 hours. If this is not reached you will unfortunately be timed out and pulled from the event at this point.

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30 Mile Route

Whilst the route is fully marked entry to the 30 is on the understanding you can navigate safely in hills or mountains and in the dark.

There are no entry requirements for this event and you can walk or trek it.

Route is Fully Marked by white Marker arrow and signage

There is a GPX file available– Note this may change due to weather conditions and or any safety issues.

The route can be followed by the GPX tracker you are wearing via an app

The route will be available on OS Maps app – we recommend the Topo Maps subscription £6.99 for 1 month)

Checkpoints

30 Mile there are 3 Checkpoints – will differ than in previous years

50 Mile there are 4 Checkpoints

These will be posted a few weeks prior and on our facebook group.

Check points will be posted on the updated list and on the GPX File.

Finish

You will come under the arch and into the Main Hall to become Cani-Trail Legends!!!

You will receive your finishers Medal and your K9 Dog Tag.

Medical

There will be paramedics in a 4x4 on duty from 0700hrs Saturday morning until completion of the 50 mile last entrant crosses the finish line. These will be around the route(s). There is also first aiders about the route and at CPs.

There is a Defibrillator at HQ, the Library at Blaengwyfi and at Gilfach Community Hall on route.

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Miscellaneous

There are Toilets at Start / Finish and showers available for all entrants after the event

Page | 5 There is water available for camping at the site along with Drinking Water

There is a snack bar on site selling Hot Food, Soft Drinks, Breakfast Sandwiches, Tea / Coffee etc (open from 0600hrs Saturday until late)
